Instructions for completing “Cremation Authorization Forms”

Find area below that pertains to your area and follow the instructions for completing

*****Please do not call the crematories listed at the top of these “cremations authorizations forms”.** These crematories, by law, can only work for funeral homes and can’t serve the general public. If you have questions regarding these forms please call cremation-online at 1-800-300-1655.

Austin Cremation Authorization Form: *(Fish Family Cremation Services)*

Page 1:

Top of page: Under heading “Identification” enter name of the deceased (we will complete the other information there). Under the same heading skip down to the **second** “Initials of Authorizing Agent” and initial declining identification.

Near bottom of page: Under heading “Pacemakers, etc” mark all that apply then initial where indicated.

Page 2:

Top of page: Under heading “Final Disposition” check #1, then under heading “Limitation of Liability” initial where indicated.

Center of page: Under heading “Signature of Authorizing Agents” date and Legal next of kin (see legal next of kin below) must sign and complete other information as indicated. (You must fax a **readable** copy of your driver’s license with paperwork.)

Dallas/Fort Worth Cremation Authorization Form: *(North Texas Funerals & Cremations Crematory)*

Page 1:

Top of page: Enter deceased name in space provided.

Center of page: Mark appropriately as to whether the deceased has pacemaker or other implants as indicated.

Page 2:

Top of page: 1) Legal next of kin (see legal next of kin below) sign by “x” (must sign in front of a notary) complete other information as indicated.

2) Notary must sign, stamp and date.

(If for some reason this form can’t be signed in front of a notary, you must fax a **readable** copy of your driver’s license.)

Center of page: Initial option #3 to waive ID viewing

Houston Cremation Authorization Form: *(Chapel of the Pines Crematory)*

1 page only:

Top of page: Enter deceased name in space provided (you may leave the other information blank, we will complete)

Center of page: Legal next of kin (see legal next of kin below) must sign by “x”
(You must fax a **readable** copy of your driver’s license with paperwork.)

Close to bottom of page: Mark appropriately as to whether the deceased has pacemaker or other implants as indicated.

Lubbock Cremation Authorization Form: (Miller Mortuary and Crematory Services)

1 page only:

Top of page: Enter the name of the deceased (*we will complete the other information*)

Bottom of page: Legal next of kin (see legal next of kin below) sign where indicated

Tyler Cremation Authorization Form: (Cedar Creek Crematory)

Page 1:

Top of page: Enter the name, age and date of death of the deceased.

Center of page: Mark appropriately as to whether the deceased has a pacemaker or other implants as indicated.

Page 2:

Top of page: Mark the block of your choice, A, B or C.

Center of page: Legal next of kin (see legal next of kin below) sign by “x” (must sign in front of a notary) complete other information as indicated.

Bottom of page: Notary must sign, stamp and date.

Waco/Temple Cremation Authorization Form: (Waco Crematory)

Page 1:

Top of page: Enter the name, age and date of death of the deceased

Center of page: “Pacemakers” mark appropriately

Page 2:

Bottom of page: Legal next of kin (see legal next of kin below) sign

***Legal Next-of-Kin** (1) **Spouse** (if still legally married or in Texas common law) is required to sign the Crematory Authorization form. If there is no spouse the legal next of kin who is closest in blood lineage to the deceased is required to sign: (2) **all adult and/or all minor children** (person who has custody of minor children has to sign for the minor), (3) **both parents**, (4) **all siblings**, etc.
